Tarvaris Jackson isn't an amazing qb but at least he doesn't throw foolish interceptions that cost his team the competition. Favre has claimed he might try and play this week. That is too bad for the Minnesota if that is the situation.

Pats Profitable - Whilst the Minnesota are finding strategies to lose with Favre, the Pats are finding means to win with Tom Brady. The Pats are 5-1 this year despite the fact that their defense is nothing special. Brady does not have Moss to throw to anymore but he still finds methods to get the position accomplished.

Vikes Worth a Play if Jackson Starts - If Favre can't go in this competition then the Vikings are worth a play. Minnesota has been aggressive all season but Favre has been giving competitions away. If Jackson obtains the start then Adrian Peterson will have a major match and Jackson will play well enough for Minnesota to win. The Pats have been successful games but it's not like they're blowing teams out.

Sunday NFL Wagering Trends - The Minnesota are 2-5 ATS in their previous 7 matches as an longshot. The Vikings are 1-6 vs the NFL football gambling number in their previous 7 road games. The New England are 24-7-2 ATS in their last 33 matches in October. The New England are 1-3-1 ATS in their last 5 games as a favorite. Taking a look at the total, the Over is 7-1 in the Vikings past 8 matches in October. The Over is 4-1 in the Minnesota last 5 road games. The Over is 6-2 in the Patriots past 8 matches total. The Under is 4-0 in the last 4 matches between the two squads.

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
