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# NFL Betting Lines - Monday Night Football

NFL betting lines handicappers will get a NFC South Division showdown of two from the leading [NFL betting](#) commodities in the NFC as New Orleans hosts Atlanta. [NFL betting lines](#) fans will evaluate a NFL betting matchup of two with the most explosive offenses in the league that are led by two of the top quarterbacks.

The Atlanta Falcons have a NFL betting lines record of 4-2 both upright and up against the spread. The Falcons are coming off a 21-37 NFL betting loss at Dallas a week ago which dropped their NFL football betting road record to 1-2 against the spread.

The New Orleans Saints have a NFL betting lines record of a ideal 6-0 both straight up and against the spread. The Saints scored a 46-34 originate from behind win more than the NFL betting lines last week at Miami as they rallied from a 24-3 deficit to acquire the money.

Saints quarterback Drew Brees and his team in no way had a doubt at Miami. "We were all talking about how we had it under control," said Brees. "It may possibly have been tough to think, but we genuinely did."

The Saints have the best ranked offense using the NFL betting lines this year and are led by Brees, who has thrown for 1698 yards so far with 14 touchdown passes plus a 67% completion rate which is good for a QB rating of 106.9.

Mike Bell and Pierre Thomas give the Saints great versatility with the NFL betting lines as they're each averaging 4.8 yards per carry or much better.

The Atlanta Falcons have a very good quantity of firepower using the NFL betting lines too. Quarterback Matt Ryan, in just his second year, has a QB rating of 90.2 good for 1360 yards having a 63% completion ratio and 11 touchdown passes.

The defenses appear fairly even as Atlanta ranks 11th using the NFL betting lines for points permitted even though New Orleans ranks 18th. The Saints have covered 7 out of their last 8 games at home when the Falcons have gone under the total in 17 out of their last 25 road games.

New Orleans has paid out to gamblers in 4 out of their last 5 home games against the Falcons. The two teams have gone under the total in 4 out of their last 6 at the Superdome.

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
