# **Tips for Winning With Video Poker**

Video Poker combines both luck along with skill. The luck part will be the cards which can be randomly dealt for the player. 1. Just Play At Full Pay Machines: One of the smartest things any potential player can perform is to look at the payout schedule before they start trying to play. The payout schedule tells you how much you'll be paid for each and every winning hand. Within a Jacks or Better Video Poker game 9/6 is known as full pay. That merely will mean that 9 coins are paid for a Full House and also 6 coins are paid for a Flush. Several casinos pay out less than 9/6, and therefore over time, you'll simply win less cash.

2. Always Make Us of Max Coins: A Mistake many beginner players make would be to play much less coins, thinking this will keep them hanging around longer. The trouble with that theory is many machines will give you proportionately a lot more coins for striking a Royal Flush using max coins than they will for hitting with less than the max. For anyone who is worried about dealing with your bankroll too soon, play at a low coin size. Or, in case you are really not sure the way to play, use a play free of charge version of the game until you have got your feet wet.

3. Plan How Much You're Happy To Lose And Follow It.: It is a lot of luck associated with winning Video Poker. Unfortunately, a lot of players keep pumping coins in the machine, considering their luck is likely to change. Successful players know that some days you've got it and several you don't. Before you start playing, have a set amount that you're prepared to lose, once that cash has disappeared quit playing.

4. Take Your Time: Video poker is a game of man against machine. Remember that there is no time limit. Ensure that you carefully take a look at cards, with each and every hand. Take just as much time as you need, no one is waiting for you so never feel pressured to make your move. Don't strike that draw button until you are ready.

5. Take advantage of the "Play free" Games: Novice players will need experience; obviously the best way to gain experience would be to play. Luckily, many online casinos offer "Play at no cost" versions of a few maybe even all their video poker versions.
