Who Is The Most Skilled Tennis Player Of All Time

When asked to pick the most skilled tennis player of all time, you will surely come up with names of Ilie Nastase, Pete Sampras, Margaret Court, Roger Taylor Manuel Orantes, Martina Navratilova, Rod Laver, Arthur Ashe, Roger Federer and Steffi Graf. To identify just one as the best is a demanding task, and therefore it is important to judge how each stands out from the rest. For instance, Ilie Nastase became recognizable, because he was a Spanish tennis player, and the Spanish respect a showman like Ilie Nastase. Consequently, he became the most fascinating player of Spain.

Arthur Ashe, being black, had to deal with a lot of prejudice from the Americans. At that time, black people were not free to use dressing rooms of some tennis clubs in the US. However, he was not to be stopped. He worked hard and his skills on the court brought him to the highest ranks of tennis in his country.

If you want to classify by the Grand Slams won, you can't omit Rod Laver. He won 4 Grand Slams in only one year in 1962 and then again in 1969. He is an amazing shot maker. He would face any complex situation with bold moves and with the least expected shot.

If we were to look at the players of the past, then one will surely think of Lew Hoad. He won each game with the smallest score. His hits would be the hardest. Then you may think of the incredible Pancho Gonzales. He almost never failed to win. Even though, when he did, he always remained confident of a win in the upcoming game.

The fact that Pete Sampras and Roger Federer rate among the best tennis players endowed with flawless manners, while on the court or off it, is unquestionable. Roger Federer has 16 Grand Slams wins and Sampras has 14 wins to his credit.

Now, let's take a look at ladies, Margaret Court, Martina Navratilova and Steffi Graf. They are all great. Their play exhilarates the fans to no end. Their play is relentless. Smooth moves, combined with sharp play makes Maria Ester Bueno, the Brazilian, one of the most exquisite players to adorn the tennis courts and enchant the fans with her poise. Roger Federer also falls into this category. Though Steffi Graf is at the top of the list, we could say that she is the most tasteful loser. Even a match lost due to health conditions, would not discourage her from showing her appreciation of the adversary with all the grace that goes with her character.

You will find that there is a number of tournaments in tennis every year. The Australian Open, French Open, Wimbledon and the US Open are the most important ones. The players are ranked by the way they perform at the matches, and how many wins they achieve. These rankings are made public.

In trying to name the best tennis player of all time, the ranking alone does not really tell you how good a player is. It just gives you the number of wins, the length of his career and number of the games played. This does not indicate the quality of the player. An early retirement will put the player low down on the list. Playing for many years will put the player on top of the list. Therefore, if you take the list to choose the best player, you will be inaccurate. It is not correct to classify the players by their position, as it would be both inappropriate and insufficient.
